Leo Song, a graduate student at University of Illinois at Urbana-Champaign, is conducting a Rigidity Clinical study

I just want to give you a quick introduction of our project. We are developing a wearable and portable device (called PVRM) strapped around the user's upper and lower arm in order to accurately assess the rigidity (tight muscles) of the users' arm. PD patients can develop rigidity, and right now the clinicians are relying on their personal interpretation to assess rigidity. So we developed this device to accurately and objectively measure rigidity. Now, we are currently performing clinical trials on patients with rigidity.
