Central Illinois Parkinson's Support Group By-Laws Synopsis

Central Illinois Parkinson's Support Group is a non-profit corporation and shall be operated exclusively for educational and charitable purposes within the meaning of Section 501c3

Central Illinois Parkinson's Support Group's purpose is to address, educate, coordinate and provide activities for persons diagnosed with Parkinson's disease, their care givers, and others working with Parkinson's and Parkinson's like diseases.

Membership: open to any person who has been diagnosed with Parkinson's disease or related disease by a medical doctor, a person who provides care for a person with Parkinson's disease, or a person who works with persons with Parkinson's disease. Voting members are all who have paid dues for the current year.

Annual meeting held in January for the election Board of Directors consisting of at least 4 and no more than 15 directors who serve a three-year term. Directors shall receive no compensation for carrying out their duties as directors. The officers of the corporation shall be a board president, vice-president, secretary, and treasurer, all of whom shall be chosen by, and serve at the pleasure of, the board of directors. The board of directors meets quarterly.

The treasurer shall produce an annual budget to the board of directors who then sets the membership dues each year.
