#### RACE AT PARKINSON'S PACE your race, your rules!

#### **Event**

This event will take place throughout the month of **SEPTEMBER**. Because it is **YOUR RACE, YOUR RULES**, we want to give everyone the flexibility to schedule their own walk/runs. There is no scheduled event location or time ... you do your race, using your schedule and your goals.
